Welcome and Introductions:

 Introductions around the room were conducted to tell who they were and what organization they represented.

Minutes:

• There was a motion to approve the minutes for our last meeting on 08.22.23. John Brown motioned to approve the minutes and Dylan Vogel seconded the motion.

Executive Director Report:

- Melissa Bias shared that Adam Warden, E.O. Officer/Financial Clerk, no longer works for Region 2 WIB; Malissa Dishman, Administrative Assistant Region 2 WIB, will now be taking the minutes.
- Melissa Bias shared that we are dealing with Generational Youth, Homeless Youth, people with disabilities, and an older population of people who need help from our One-Stop Partners.

Youth Presentations:

- Affiona Brown discussed progression of one of her youth, Hillary Muncy, who had no High School Diploma. Hillary graduated in February 2023 through our Youth Program using Penn Foster High School. Hillary completed a Work Experience Contract, in August 2023, through our Youth Program working with Mingo County Clerk's Office and is now enrolled in Med-Care taking Phlebotomy/MA training. Affiona also updated us on her Community Outreach visits. She went to Lily's Place, which has a Family Center and a Neonatal Accident Center. She also visited the Western Regional Co. Jail and the Western Regional Day Report Center reaching out to all of their youth.
- Jakki Jackson told us about her youth, Jacob Davenport, a High School drop-out, who chose to test and passed the Hi-set on his first try. He is now in our United States Armed Forces Training and has a bright future ahead. Jakki also introduced another youth, Anna Dishman, who is now working for Region 2 Workforce Investment Board through a Youth Work Experience Contract. Anna spoke to us and shared what all the youth program has been offering her, including the opportunity to be enrolled in the LPN Program at Collins Career Center beginning January 2024. Jakki also visited the Marcum Terrace Family Resource Center as her Community Outreach to their youth.
- Burcu Delph had a youth attend our youth council meeting, Danyon Hayward, who is
 currently in our Penn Foster program. He spoke, with Burcu's coaching, and informed us
 of his progress in the youth program. Burcu also has other youth who are working in
 Work Experience Contracts, and she told us about how progress is being made at their
 jobs. Burcu informed us of her Community Outreach at Golden Girls Home reaching out
 to their youth.
